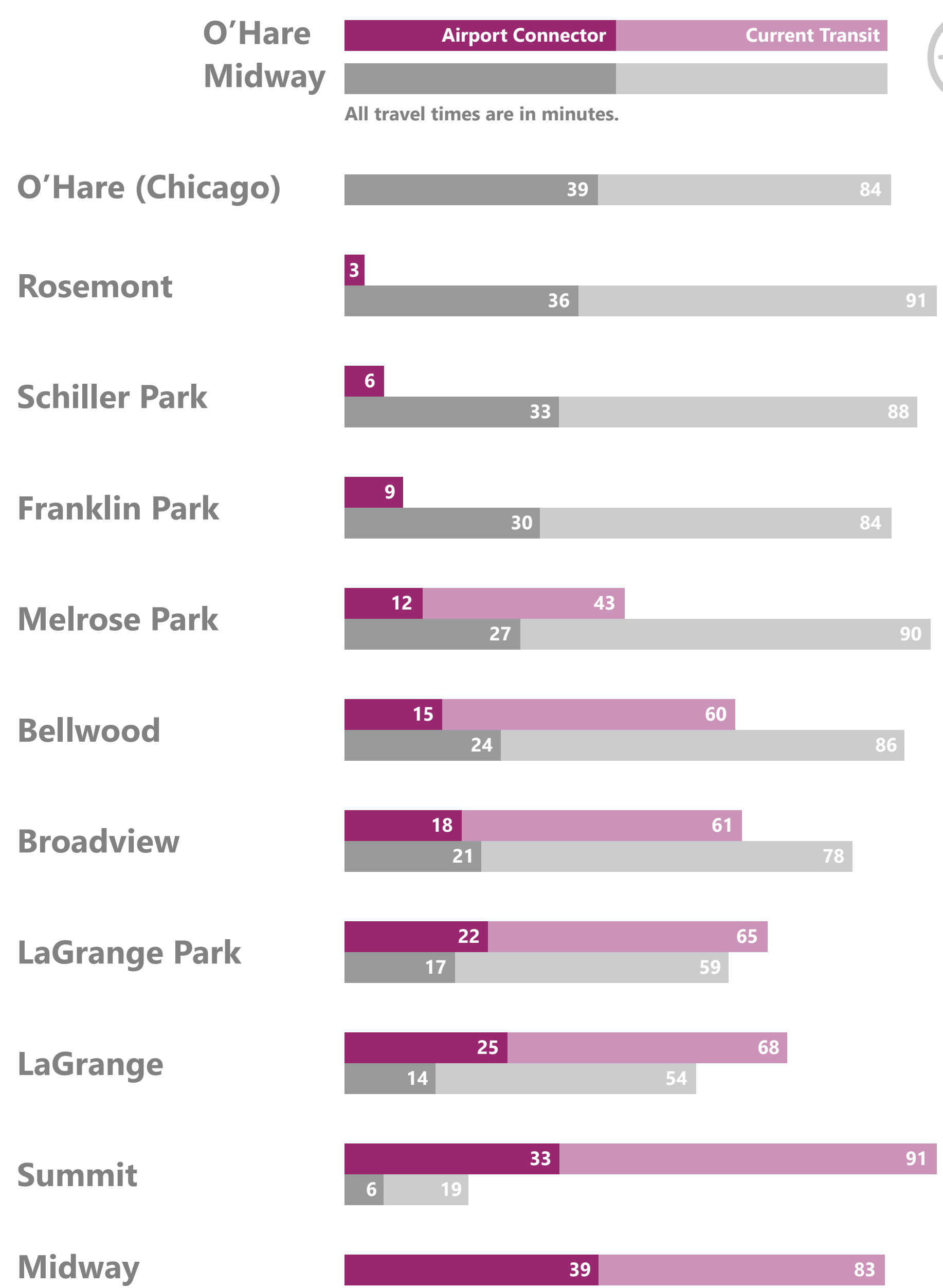


## About the Project

The **Airport Connector Express** would create a new transit service between Chicago's Midway and O'Hare Airports. Fast and frequent service along a rail or bus rapid transit (BRT) corridor would connect West Cook County municipalities with both airports and one another. If implemented, the Airport Connector Express could cut transit travel times from Midway to O'Hare by as much as 50 percent.

## What is Transit Future?

Transit Future is a campaign to raise new funding for transit in Cook County. Launched in 2014, the campaign aims to establish a dedicated revenue source that could support up to \$20 billion in transit expansion projects. This would transform Chicago's hub-and-spoke rail network into a system that serves the needs of 21st-century commuters.
